Meeting called to order by President Tom Savage at 6:30 p.m..

Approval of Agenda Motion, made by Adrienne Evans and seconded by Lindsey Smith, motion carried (This motion included the Approval of this agenda and the previous meeting's minutes).

#### Treasurer's Report (Carol Maidon)

The report was sent out by Carol, she asked if there were any questions.

As of March 11, 2024 Income was \$2,886.58 with expenses being \$6,566.55 leading to a total income of \$-3,679.97 (please note typical net income for this time of year when not yet collecting dues, PDI registration and vendor fees) Assets are \$60,145.34 in 2 checking accounts and \$74,871.22 in 3 savings accounts. ### PDI Updates/Beginning Teacher's Workshop (Manley/Joette/Cliff)

PDI Committee met last week.

Job lists for PDI were updated in the NCSTA folder, there are a few gaps, it was a productive meeting

Need Elementary Share-A-Thon leader, Laura Lowder did this last year

Brian Whitson will oversee Publicity, we need a Committee Chair to lead stuffing of the PDI bags for attendees, and needs for Prize Chair

Geology Keynote has fallen through, National Geographic is a possibility but we had one a few years back; suggested speaker for Biology a possibility

Contingency Plan—Friday having a Keynote Diversity/Equity included in grant from Burroughs-Wellcome, Food after this on Friday, our food minimum would help with this

PDI committee moving forward without a workshop format similar to the one last year Kelly Ficklen mentioned that she has an Astronaut friend, Leland Melvin that she could reach out to. Brad Rhew gave feedback that those attendees last year were excited about what they took aware from the Friday workshop but missed sessions during that day; could we offer ½ day of sessions and ½ day workshop split. Could there be heavy emphasis on Friday regarding the

New Science Standards for the state. Carie F. suggested a double-blocked session which would be intense on the standards for new teachers. She further mentioned that we could have 15 minutes in those sessions with experienced teachers that could demonstrate and give best practices, 4-5 people could share. We need to support our BT's in this process since standards are changing for the first time in 15 years. Manley states that some of these sessions could be 1 hour and 50 minutes or two hours to allow for this built in time with 4-5 people sharing, there could be 10 minute transitions between both sessions.

Lottie Peppers, Carie F. and Adrienne said they would take the lead on this as well as Jill Francis and Kristen Kane; good descriptions for this will be used in the Sched App.

Carrie F. also mentioned if would we be able to have a short meet & greet with our districts so there could be networking taking place amongst attendees from their own districts with their District Director, this could be done during some of the Exhibit Hall times, given our long lunch hour.

#### **Contract Renewals**

Joette 2 Year Renewal Contract; at this point Joette and Manley left the meeting, Adrienne will send a text message to let them back in online.

It is time for renewal of Joette's contract with Manley as Conference Coordinator, there is no conflict of interest with Manley staying on the board

What does the Business Manager's job entail?

- Financials for the organization
- IRS filings
- Registration for PDI, etc.
- Multiple Checking and Saving Accounts
- Contacts from School Systems

What is the Conference Coordinator's job description?

- Reserving Venue for PDI
- Coordinate with Vendors
- Communication with Benton and Logistics there

Contract is \$50,000 to be split in half, this salary has not been raised in the last 8-9 years.

Both Joette and Manley go above and beyond to this organization because of their love for Science in the state of North Carolina. Other folks would not give that level of commitment to an organization.

Motion from the Executive Board is to renew the contract for Joette as Business Manager for two years, this motion does not require a second being that it is coming from a committee. Tom Savage calls for the vote and it passes unanimously.

#### Joette's Webmaster Contract

This motion to approve the \$4,000 contract for two years came from Executive Committee with no need for a second. Motion is to renew the Webmaster Contract with Joette Midgett for two years to manage our NCSTA website at a valued amount of \$4,000. This motion passes unanimously.

Contract includes a 90 day clause to give notice, this has always been the case.

Adrienne Evans texts Joette and Manley to come back in to the Zoom meeting.

PDI Motions were tabled at this time.

#### **Budget Revisions (Carol Maidon)**

Carol sent this out through email earlier this week. Reasons for these revisions:

- Change of venue equals an increase for the food line item
- There is a decrease in the travel budgeted to Greensboro since we are returning to Winston-Salem

This budget is very similar with a few minor differences.

The Executive Committee brings the motion after input from the Finance Committee. Motion was made to accept those revisions to the budget reflecting the Benton Convention Center adjustments, motion carries.

### **Operations Report (Joette Midgett)**

NCSTA new logo to consider, deadline for this would be in the next week or so Discussion: Getting permanent nametags/badges; logo to go on the nametags and order after it's done. Goal is to have these nametags when we are at other events and conferences We can stick with the paper version until new logo.

What shape will these be, board will need to vote after Executive Board consideration. Any new logo must come before the board. Possible formation of a 2-3 committee member to look into this, we need to fast track this and not wait until the next meeting. Graphic artist already looking into this
