- 5. Awards Committee Motion for Approval of Grants (Brad Rhew)

Motion: The Grants Committee moves to approve 2 curriculum grants and 1 study grant. Motion was approved by board unanimously; no 2nd required.

- Curriculum Grant winners are Covey Denton (\$700) and Wayne Shore (\$700).
- The Study Grant winner is Kelly Pike for \$592.50.
- Covey Denton will use her grant for Hands-On Inquiry Based Virtual 3-D Printing.
- Wayne Shore's grant will expand his building robotics Lego Competition; \$967.18 was asked for but \$700 was funded.
- Kelly Pike will use the Study Grant to be certified in Challenge Based Learning Community STEM group. This will provide a sustainable impact for school and community.
- 7 grant proposals came in narrowed down to five; 3 were approved.
- The flyers and email correspondence helped to get the word out about grants; largest numbers in many years.
- Brad Rhew thanked his committee (Carrie Jones and Nick Weeks).

## 6. Outreach to Members (Carol Maidon)

- Elementary Teachers Group: Laura Lowder, Brad Rhew and Manley Midgett
- Request for board members to register for these webinars
- They will feature 25 things at home to Learn Science; have 50-60 registrations so far with one week left to register.
- 1st one is October 1st from 4:30-6 p.m.; the other 2 sessions will be October 15th and 29th (with 25 more things to learn science at home in each session). These will be advertised to our members via an announcement and through the DPI newsletter and by Science House.

- 1 registration gets you in to all 3 sessions; free for members and \$30 for nonmembers and this gets them a membership.
- NCSTA will be promoted and there will be a Q&A session.
- Format for these webinars will be via Zoom. Meredith will provide Zoom account and tech support for the sessions.
- Please register for these sessions.
